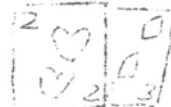

GENERAL MEETING - OCTOBER 22, 1964

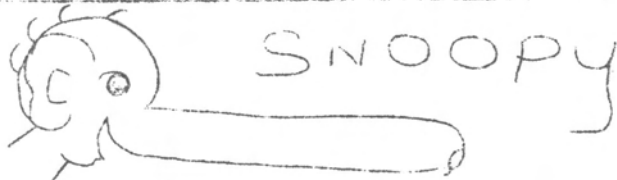
