

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This form is issued under the authority of Act 162, P.A. of 1982. The articles of incorporation cannot be filed until this form, or a comparable document, is submitted.
- Submit one original copy of this document. Upon filing, a microfilm copy will be prepared for the
 records of the Corporation and Securities Bureau. The original copy will be returned to the address
 appearing in the box above as evidence of filing.

Since this document must be microfilmed, it is important that the filing be legible. Documents with poor black and white contrast, or otherwise illegible, will be rejected.

- 3. This document is to be used pursuant to the provisions of Act 182, P.A. of 1982 by one or more persons for the purpose of forming a domestic nonprofit corporation.
- 4. ARTICLE II The purpose for which the corporation is organized must be included. It is not sufficient to state that the corporation may engage in any activity within the purposes for which corporations may be organized under the Act.
- 5. ARTICLE III Complete item III(1) or III(2) as appropriate, but not both.
- 6. ARTICLE IV A post office box may not be designated as the street address of the registered office. The mailing address may differ from the address of the registered office only if a post office box address in the same city as the registered office is designated as the mailing address.
- 7. ARTICLE V The Act requires one or more incorporators. The addresses should include a street number and name (or other designation), city and state.
- 8. This document is effective on the date approved and filed by the Bureau. A later effective date, no more than 90 days after the date of delivery, may be stated as an additional article.
- 9. This document must be signed in ink by each incorporator. However, if there are 3 or more incorporators, they may, by resolution adopted at the organizational meeting by a written instrument, designate one of them to sign the articles of incorporation on behalf of all of them. In such event, these articles of incorporation must be accompanied by a copy of the resolution duly cartified by the acting secretary at the organizational meeting and a statement must be placed in the articles incorporating that resolution into them.

Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation – adopted 5-23-07

Add Article VI to read:

Article VI – Personal Liability of volunteer directors, volunteer officers, members, and other volunteers

The volunteer directors or volunteer officers of the Forest Park Home Owner's Association Inc, a non profit corporation, shall not be personally liable to the corporation or its members for monetary damages for a breach of a director's or officer's fiduciary duty, except in the instance of:

- 1. A breach of the director's or officer's duty of loyalty to the corporation or its members;
- 2. Acts or omissions not in good faith or that involve intentional gross misconduct or a knowing violation of law;
- 3. A violation of section 551 (1) of Act 162 Public Acts of 1982;
- 4. A transaction from which the director or officer derived an improper personal benefit;
- 5. An act or omission occurring before adoption of this provision;
- 6. An act or omission that is grossly negligent.

No member or shareholder of the Forest Park Home Owner's Association Inc, a nonprofit corporation, shall be held personally liable to the corporation.

The Forest Park Home Owner's Association, Inc, a nonprofit corporation, assumes the liability for all acts or omissions of a volunteer director, volunteer officer, or other volunteer occurring on or after May 25, 2007 granting limited liability if all of the following are met:

- 1. The volunteer was acting or reasonably believed he or she was acting within the scope of his or her authority.
- 2. The volunteer was acting in good faith.
- 3. The volunteer's conduct did not amount to gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct.
- 4. The volunteer's conduct was not an intentional tort.

This provision may be included in the Forest Park Home Owner's Association By-Laws.
